

- According to a brief by the Israel Policy Forum, an American Jewish organization, the establishment of illegal Israeli settlements in the Occupied West Bank, thus securing dominance over the territory and ultimately annexing the region, has been driven by messianic ideology, which impels Jews to claim the entire stretch from the Jordan River to the Mediterranean Sea as the Land of Israel, thereby completely erasing Palestine.
- 10 The War on Gaza was initially confined to Israel and its occupied Palestinian territory. Responding to Houthi attacks, in support for Palestine, on ships connected to Israel in the Red Sea, the United States and its allies carried out several attacks on rebel sites in Yemen. Israel, in its attempt to neutralize Hezbollah, is repeatedly sending rockets into Southern Lebanon and bombed a residential building in Beirut. On April 1, 2024, Israel bombed the Iranian Consulate in Damascus, Syria, killing two Iranian generals and five officers. As people gathered in large groups around the trucks, Israeli troops opened fire, and the people scattered. After the first round of shooting stopped, they returned to the trucks, only for the soldiers to open fire once more, and the tanks advanced. An Israeli spokesman initially insisted that the troops were only trying to protect themselves and that the victims were part of an unruly mob which did not get out of the way of the tanks, but hospital workers confirmed that many of those killed had been . No Israelis were harmed.

One witness described a scene of "total destruction." He said that several buildings had been burned down and that he had counted six bodies in the area, including two in the courtyard. Another resident said, "The situation is indescribable. The occupation destroyed all sense of life here." He explained that army bulldozers had ploughed over a makeshift cemetery inside the compound, where there were

- 54 According to a new report released by the World Bank and the United Nations, more than a million people in Gaza are without homes; eighty-four percent of health facilities have been damaged or destroyed; the water and sanitation system has nearly collapsed; and the education system has completely broken down. At an estimated cost of 18.5 billion dollars—an amount equal to 97 percent of the combined GDP of the West Bank and Gaza in 2022, damage to Gaza's ______ is catastrophic.

He traveled to Israel after the October 7 attack, provided Israel with huge quantities of munitions, refused to call for a ceasefire, and vetoed UN ceasefire resolutions. 



At the end of March 2024, <i>The Washington Post</i> reported that, despite growing worldwide calls for an arms embargo, the Biden administration approved the transfer of billions of dollars worth of new weapons shipments to Israel, including warplanes and 2,000-pound bombs, which the <i>New York Times</i> , in December, had described as "one of the most destructive munitions in Western military arsenals"—a weapon that "unleashes a blast wave and metal fragments thousands of feet in every direction." These weapons, are almost never deployed by Western militaries in densely populated locations due to the risk of civilian casualties. (Other books offer different interpretations of the Apocalypse.) On the other hand, for some Evangelical Christians, who strongly support this radical Zionism, the erection of the Temple would enable the return of Christ and the fulfillment of the End Times in which devout Christians would be welcomed into heaven, and the Jews who did not convert would be condemned to hell. One has to wonder how these two conflicting beliefs can be reconciled and whether either is true.
